

Safe Space Responsibilities



LGBTIQA+ YOUTH ONLY

FC is for LGBTIQA+ young people aged 12 - 25.
Support workers and carers are the exception.

NO PICK-UP OR PUT-DOWN ZONE

1. It's not a place to find someone to date
2. We don't tolerate discrimination, hate or bigotry towards other visitors or our team.



WE DON'T JOKE ABOUT THE SERIOUS STUFF

This includes mental-health, suicide, violence or abuse.

LOCKED DOOR POLICY

For everyone's safety, have an FC team member let you **in** or **out**.



WHAT HAPPENS AT FC STAYS AT FC

We don't talk about who we saw or other people's business when we leave.



WE'RE A SOBER SPACE WITH A FOCUS ON HARM REDUCTION

You won't be welcome under the influence of illicit drugs or alcohol and we don't glorify substance use.

WARN YOUR CONTENT!

"Before I keep going, just a content warning for (sexualised content/transphobia/violence etc.), in case you'd rather not discuss this?"
Give pause for consent and you're good to go.



YOU ARE YOUR BEST ADVOCATE

We want to foster a space to talk about the sticky topics in a safe way.

You know yourself and your triggers best. If you're not comfortable with a conversation, it is your responsibility to opt out of participating in it.

Need help with this? Let our team know!



WE'RE NOT A SICK BAY

Are you in a state to participate?
Remember that FC is a social drop-in space.
If you are feeling ill or at risk as it may result in us needing to reach out to your emergency contacts.



DRESS CODE

We want you to express yourself.
But no sexualised/fetish clothing or paraphernalia.

KEEP IT PLATONIC

Keep physical touching to a maximum of fist bumps, if you wanna snuggle - go outside.



BANS AND WARNINGS

Breaking any of these rules could result in your FC membership being revoked temporarily or permanently.

It is the FC team's responsibility to keep the space safe - what they say goes.
