Freedom Centre's 2025 Design Competition Entry Form

Freedom Centre is looking for some amazing new designs for our signature badges and other resources, and we want them to be created **by LGBTIQA+ young people**!

Artists will retain the copyright to their work, and by entering into this competition, they consent to have the submitted design or artwork licensed to WAAC (as the parent company of Freedom Centre) for use in, and promotion of their services.

1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Please carefully read the Eligibility & Entry Criteria

Entrants must:

- Identify as LGBTIQA+; diverse in sex, sexuality, and/or gender
- Be aged 12 to 25 years old (as of the day on which they entered)
- Currently live or reside in Western Australia
- Own the copyright of any work submitted, and said artwork must be completely original and not Al
 generated in any way

You may enter up to 2 entries - but note that if you are selected as a winner multiple times you will only receive one gift card (the highest value won) but will receive other additional prizes.

2. PRIZES & EXHIBITION

All submitted designs:

- Will have the opportunity to have their work displayed as part of a gallery exhibition
- Where possible, artists will receive their design as a badge

The winners:

- All winners will receive a certificate, a framed print of their design, and have their art (and optionally their bios) posted on Freedom Centre's socials and website
- Minor winners will receive a \$50 gift card
- Major winners will receive a \$150 gift card and their design produced on a piece of merch (details depending on what is feasible with the design)



3. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. The Artwork/Design:

- Must follow the theme of: Queer History The events and people that shaped what it means to be LGBTIQA+ now, and be appropriate to be used by Freedom for the intended purpose in services and for promotion.
- Can be digital or physical artwork, but must be submitted as a PNG or JPEG file. Physical artwork will need to be submitted as either a high quality picture or as a scan (at a minimum resolution of 300 dpi).
- Please note that artwork may need to be adjusted in order to be used and physical art may have to be digitally recreated if it is a winning entry, so may not be 100% the original work.
- Physical artwork that has been scanned and submitted digitally may need to be re-scanned by WAAC and Freedom Centre if selected as a winner to ensure highest possible printing quality.



5. ENTRY EXAMPLES

Badge Design Size:

All badges will be printed at a size of 38mm and when made will show 36mm - So Please be aware that your design should be legible at that size and that some details on the edges may not be visible .
